

# Merchandise Manager 5-1-2009 Enhancements

## Balance the cash drawer

Clear up the balance cash drawer screen. Previous versions displayed 'Other' in the Paid Out section. Now it displays 'Paid Out'

Systems using touch screen terminals were not able to enter a negative amount in the paid out section. Keyboards were the only way to enter a negative amount. Now, when a positive number is entered in the Paid Out section, the amount will be converted to a negative amount.
